WHEREAS, the Committee on Appointments is established pursuant to Standing Order 190(4) which provides for vetting and consideration by the County Assembly, appointments under Article 179(2) (b) of the Constitution, in this case the County Executive Committee Members;

AWARE THAT, Section 35 and 36 of the County Governments Act as read together with Article 179(2) (b) of the Constitution provides for the power of the Governor to nominate and appoint County Executive Committee Members with the approval of the County Assembly;

FURTHER APPRECIATIVE THAT, Section 35 (1) of the County Government Act provides that the Governor shall, when nominating members of the County Executive Committee consider the following:

- a) The composition of the County Executive Committee reflects the community and cultural diversity of the County; and
- b) Take into account the principles of affirmative action as provided for in the Constitution.
