009/2022: Hon. Sharon Jerotich Keter, MCA, Baringo County, seeks a statement from the **Leader of the Majority Party** on the following matters of concern:

A mother in Salmo Soi, Ng'aratuko area recently passed on three weeks after delivery of her new born. It is alleged that she sadly died due to starvation. It is common knowledge that the entire Country is facing serious cases of starvation that has been occasioned by Climate Change leading to low yield of food crops across the entire Country.

Reports indicates that over 3.1 million Kenyans in arid and semi-arid areas are severely food insecure, following three consecutive poor rain seasons that has tampered crop production
